Due to the uncertainty and concern surrounding COVID-19, the Parachute Industry Association has decided to postpone the 2021 PIA Symposium to August 2021. The Symposium events will now start Sunday, August 29 and will end on Friday, September 3. The 2nd Regular Business Meeting for 2021 will take place between Friday, August 27 and Sunday, August 29. We anticipate co-locating with USPA for their regular events.

After careful consideration of health hazards and limitations on large gatherings, as well as extensive negotiations with all the parties involved, the Executive Committee authorized postponement of the Symposium event. The August date was chosen as it presented the best compromise between multiple factors, such as a reasonable expectation that the event will proceed in a normal and safe manner, hotel availability, and coordination with other industry events scheduled for the Summer of 2021.
