WEBBING, TEXTILE, WOVEN NYLON, FOR DECELERATORS

The Parachute Industry Association makes this document available for use by Industry and Government organizations that wish to apply this specification to their products.

1. SCOPE

1.1 Scope. This specification covers six types of Class I nylon webbing (shuttleloom weaving only).

1.2 Classification. The nylon webbing shall be of the types specified in 6.1. The types shall conform to the requirements of TABLE I as applicable for the type specified.

2. APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS
