WEBBING, TEXTILE, COTTON, GENERAL PURPOSE, NATURAL OR IN COLORS

The Parachute Industry Association makes this document available for use by Industry and Government organizations that wish to apply this specification to their products.

1. SCOPE

1.1 **Scope.** This document covers various types of cotton webbing.

1.2 **Classification.** The webbing shall be of the following types and classes as specified (see 6.2):

- Type II — Medium weight webbing (hard texture)
- Type IIa — Medium weight webbing (soft texture)
- Type IIb — Medium heavyweight webbing
- Type III — Heavyweight webbing
- Type IV — Webbing, special use
- Type V — Webbing, multiple weave
- Type VI — Webbing, special (appliances and wicks)
- Class 1 — Natural
- Class 1a — Natural, water repellent, mildew resistant,
2, 2' methylenebis-(4-chlorophenol) (see 6.5)
- Class 1b — Natural, water repellent, mildew resistant
(copper-8-quinolinolate)

Class 2a — Bleached, water repellent, mildew resistant 2, 2' methylenebis-(4-chlorophenol) (see 6.5)

Class 3 — Dyed

Class 4 — Dyed, water repellent, mildew resistant (copper 8-quinolinolate)

Class 7 — Dyed, water repellent, mildew resistant, 2, 2' methylenebis-(4-chlorophenol) (see 6.5)

Class 8 — Dyed, water repellent
