# **CLOTH, DUCK, NYLON**

The Parachute Industry Association makes this document available for use by Industry and Government organizations that wish to apply this specification to their products.

# 1. SCOPE

- 1.1 <u>Scope</u>. This specification covers the requirements for nylon cloth woven for use in the manufacture of parachute packs and other military items.
- 1.2 <u>Type designation</u>. The cloth covered by this specification will be of the following Types and Classes, as specified in 6.2:

Type I - 9.5 oz./sq. yd. maximum

Type II - 8.75 oz./sq. yd. maximum

Type III - 7.25 oz./sq. yd. maximum

Class 1 - Untreated

Class 2 - Nondurable water repellent treated

Class 3 - Durable water repellent treated (DWR)

Class 4 - Durable water repellent treated with IR requirements

Class 5 - Woodland Camouflage Pattern and durable water repellent treated (Type III only)

Class 6 - Deleted

Class 7 - Operational Camouflage Pattern (OCP) and durable water repellant treated (Type III only)
